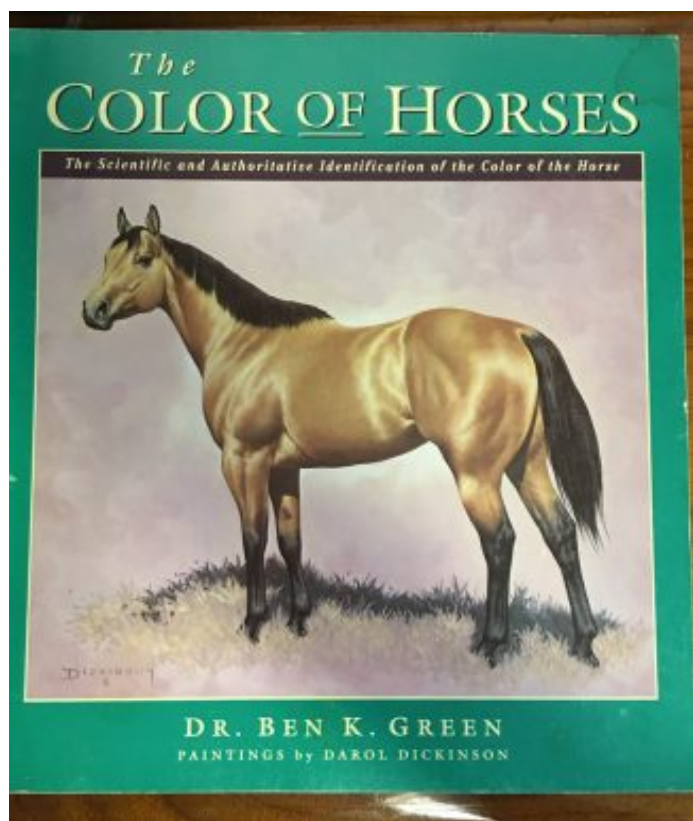

Horses seemed less vulnerable to scalding and chafing by saddles and cinches. Green decided that if a horse's color has anything to do with its stamina, intelligence, or soundness, he had better learn about it. He became a horse trader, a horse breeder, and finally a veterinarian.

Dr. Green began his research into equine coloration in the 1940's in West Texas where, as he put it, "Horses were cheap and there was an array of colors that was unmatched anywhere else in North America." he continued his studies in Europe, south America, and the Middle East. Dr. Green compiled his discoveries into this well-documented and easy-to-read book, originally published in 1974, about why equine color occurs as it does and how to identify it.
